

Questions Asked by Webinar Attendees – 01/20/09

Q: I see how important internships can be. How and where do you go to find internships?

A: It depends on the type of internship. Usually, a good place to start looking is in your area, or talking to people you know. Many companies have some sort of internship options available. There are also many websites that assist with finding internships. Our coaches will be able to guide you through the process of where to look for internships.

Q: May I know how many students are currently enrolled in CollegePlus? Which state has the highest enrollees?

A: We have roughly 600 students currently enrolled in CollegePlus! The state with the most students in our program is Texas (where our headquarters are located).

Q: I'm from the Philippines. I have a daughter, who's now 15 and a high school sophomore. She's been homeschooled since 2nd grade. She would like to try CollegePlus! Would you be able to help us step by step how to start? Also, should my daughter decide to enroll, I would prefer that she communicates with her coach on a regular basis. How do you go about this? I would appreciate your help. Thank you.

A: Yes, absolutely. We would be happy to guide you along the way. There is a testing center in the Philippines (Makati), where your daughter could take tests that are required for her degree. Should your daughter enroll, she would talk to her coach on the phone or through video/computer audio once every other week for about an hour. In between these coaching calls, your daughter can communicate with her coach by email or chat.

Q: Are you suggesting that one not use the ADL CollegePlus! concept for obtaining a masters?

A: It is possible to get a Masters degree through distance learning methods. However, it is not nearly as cost or time effective as an undergraduate degree.

Q: The testimonies are encouraging. Have you surveyed your clients across the board to determine what they are doing a year after graduation and what their incomes are?

A: We are in the process of collecting detailed statistics. We do however, know that a number of our students have used CollegePlus! as a stepping stone to Masters or PhD programs.

Q: I have a BA already but am looking at another. Can your system help me?
